The school will provide a sausage sizzle for lunch that day.

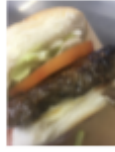

Why?

Not only are the students the best people to tell their parents what they have been learning, but we believe that students build on their learning by communicating what they know. Providing an opportunity for students to tell their family what they know can significantly boost that learning.

A strong link between the home and school is an essential component to academic success and forward progress. Without the support and trust of the parents, what the classroom teacher is trying to achieve may not come to fruition.

The goal of every parent and teacher should be that their students develop a strong sense of responsibility while becoming increasingly independent throughout their schooling. The bottom-line is accountability. The students need to be accountable for their own successes and failures and develop a strong sense of intrinsic motivation based on those experiences.
