## Healthy Daily Habits FOR KIDS

**HAIR**  
Brush or comb your hair twice a day to keep the tangles out. Never share your brush or comb.



**TEETH**  
Brush teeth twice a day - after breakfast and before you go to bed.



**NAILS**  
Keep fingernails and toenails clean and trim them once a week. Bath time is usually best for trimming and cleaning under the nails.

Learning Support (formerly Special Education) and the RTLB service (Resource Teachers Learning and Behaviour) have teamed up with schools/kura and early childhood, iwi and community providers to work together with the sole purpose of providing support for your tamariki and their learning needs.

Te Manawa Tahī is a learning support hub where you can come in and talk to education professionals about your child’s learning. This is a free service.

If you have a concern about your child’s language development, learning progress, social and emotional wellbeing, or behaviour, Te Manawa Tahī have specialists available so you can discuss your concerns directly with them. Through this discussion they will determine what help may be required and identify next steps for you as a family.
